Mandatory Practice will begin on November 5. Practices are held on Monday/Tuesday (TBD by team vote) and Thursday (7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade) and Monday/Tuesday (TBD by team vote) (6<sup>th</sup> grade) after school from 3:25-5:00 PM. Participation in both practices each week is encouraged. Attendance at one session per week is required.

**Tournaments -** The district sponsored tournaments are scheduled as follows:

February 27 District tournament Area School, to be announced

April 17 State tournament Hoover High School

Additional invitational tournaments will be added as they are announced by the sponsoring schools. Information is posted via the Scholar's Bowl Team Schoology class. Members will be provided the code upon submission of the commitment form at dues. Parents should sign-up for Schoology parent access to ensure receipt of team messages.

The cost for team participation is \$25 to cover the district/state fees and supplies. Please include a check with this form. If a student took a Scholar's Bowl class during fall semester and paid the \$25 fee, then dues are not required. Please indicate if the fee was paid at the end of this form. Remember to include a driver's license number and phone number on all checks. Cost for the invitational tournaments is paid by the students who participate. Invitational tournament costs are typically \$10-\$15 per student. Please provide the dues with this signed commitment form if you did not pay the fees with a Scholar's Bowl class. If you feel that you will not be able to participate due to financial considerations, please contact Mr. Sippel (7/8) or Ms. Baragona (6).

Transportation to tournaments is the responsibility of the parent. Due to the relatively small size of our team, bus transportation is not cost effective. Please make arrangements with another team parent if you would like to carpool.

Purchase and use of question sets for practice outside of regular team practices is prohibited unless approved by the coach. Please do not use any question sets found on the internet either. It is highly disruptive to the effectiveness of practice if some team members have already used a question set. If students or parents want extra sets to practice with outside of class or team practice please contact the coach so that we can coordinate our efforts.

Please understand that Scholar's bowl is a competitive team event. All students may participate in the Fun tournament and any of the invitational tournaments. However, we are limited to a 6 member team for the MS district and state tournaments (7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> only). Students will be chosen for the district and state teams based upon participation and performance statistics in practice, the Fun tournament and the invitational tournaments.

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6th grade students and any 5<sup>th</sup> grade team members zoned for Discovery may attend the "Elementary School Open" state tournament for 5/6 on the same day as the MS state tournament. The 6 member team will be chosen based upon participation and performance statistics throughout the season.

National Tournament – Participation of the 7/8<sup>th</sup> team in the National Tournament will be at the discretion of the coach and administration based upon competitiveness and teamwork factors. Should we qualify for and choose to attend the NAQT National Championship Tournament in Chicago, all students attending will be required to have a legal guardian accompany them. The team will be chosen based upon performance and participation using the same criteria as the state team. Team members, guardians and coaches will be required to travel together with the team as arranged by the coach. National Championship team members will have additional practice expectations to ensure competitiveness at the tournament.
